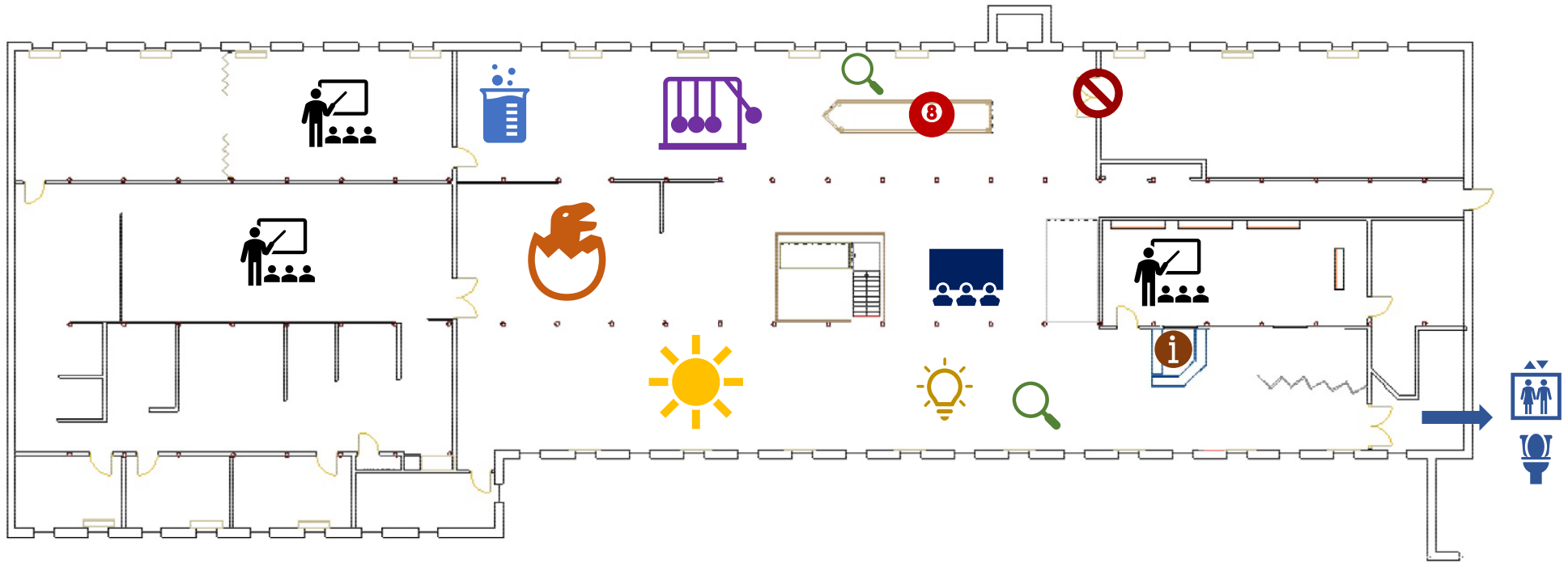

T for Touch - Touch is how we Touch things, using hands or other parts of the body.

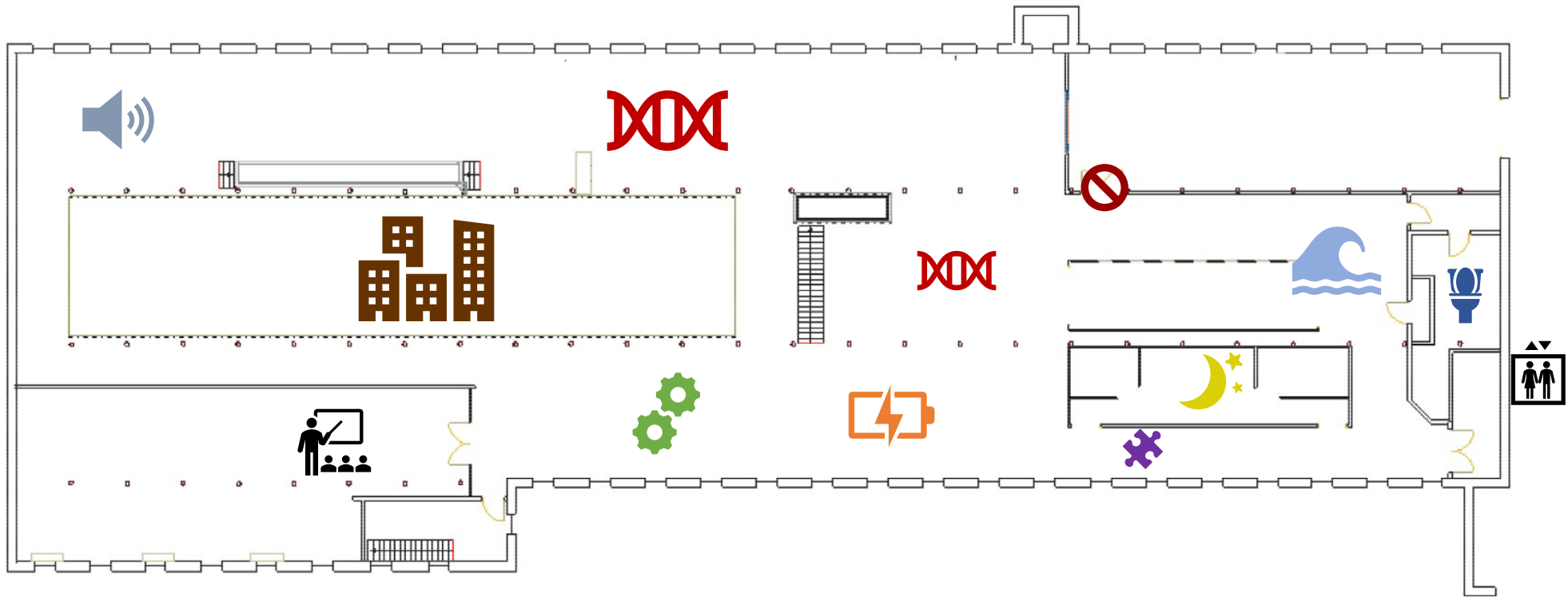
S for Smell - The ability to recognize and process scents, like food and other objects.
