
My Visit to the SEE Science Center: A Social Story

will know I am there.






I can walk up the stairs or take the elevator to the 4th floor to get to the museum.

I can learn about dinosaurs and dig for fossils.




There may be other visitors using exhibits. We can take turns.

I will know it is time for a demonstration when I hear an announcement






There are more exhibits downstairs.


To get down to the 3rd floor, I will walk down a large staircase.
